

In a recent meeting with Duke Energy, they informed the Trinity Bar H.O.A that they have started the construction of replacing the large metal lattice electrical tower with a single steel pole

What does this mean for the community?

Construction traffic coming in and out of the community will increase The entrance foliage leading to that tower will be removed during the project The entrance foliage will be completely replaced once the project is complete The Gazebo will be temporarily moved to the small field near the playground A temporary pole will be erected near the playground sign They estimate that this project will be completed by December 2022
