New Locks at The Pool

You may not have noticed yet since it's chilly season, but the two gates at the pool have been replaced with electronic key fobs. Unfortunately there's been a delay getting the internet setup at the pool house. Spectrum estimates that they will be finished mid-January. Once complete, key fobs will be issued to all homes.

We have setup a temporary code that will give you access to the pool area. This code will expire once all of the key fobs have been distributed.
